Walk with the Stars Midnight Walk

Please could you help support The Hospice of St Francis and encourage staff, parents and children over 11, to sign up to this great event by hanging up a few of our posters in prominent places?

The Hospice of St Francis cares for people from Dacorum, St Albans, Harpenden, Markyate, Chesham, Amersham and surrounding villages. We are the only inpatient unit with special facilities that allow patients to be cared for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We also help patients who are seriously ill at home and in day hospice. To run these services we need to raise more than £3.3m every year.

'Walk with the Stars' is our biggest fundraising event of the year and is taking place on 19th June. It's our fourth annual Midnight walk and we need to recruit as many 'pink ladies' as possible.

Last year over 1300 women walked from Hemel Hempstead to Berkhamsted and back again and between them they raised a staggering £215,000 in one night. This money is vital to the on going care that we give to local men and women with life limiting illness.

Why not get together some of the staff, pupils and parents and enter as a team. We also need **men** to help marshal the route and make our walkers feel safe at midnight.
